this particular case the lender recorded a Notice of Default on 11/25/14. The Association can only		
pursue this debt via a Superior Court Action as the debt exceeds the jurisdictional limit for Small		
Claims. We have banking information for the owners. It is recommended to initiate a Superior		
Court Action. UTS will work with our attorneys collaboratively on the file. The attorney retainer		

fee is \$1,500.
